AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CERTIFICATION BY CITY AND TOWN CLERKS OF RULES AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY PLANNING BOARDS AND THE TRANSMISSION THEREOF TO THE REGISTER OF DEEDS AND RECORDER OF THE LAND COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The next to the last sentence of section 81Q of chapter 41
2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out, in line 8,
3 the words "certified copies thereof" and inserting in place thereof
4 the words: — copies thereof certified by such clerk, or by the
5 planning board, as provided in section eighty-one N, — so as to
6 read as follows: — A copy certified by such clerk of any such
7 rules and regulations, or any amendment thereof, adopted after
8 the first day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-four, shall
9 be transmitted forthwith by such planning board to the register
10 of deeds and recorder of the land court, and no rule or regula-
11 tion, or amendment thereof, adopted thereafter, under this sec-
12 tion shall be effective until copies thereof certified by such clerk,
13 or by the planning board, as provided in section eighty-one N
14 have been so transmitted.
