AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF THE JUDGE AND ASSOCIATE
JUDGES OF THE LAND COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 14 of chapter 185 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in section 3 of chapter 733 of the acts of 1955, is
3 hereby amended by striking out, in line 3, the word "nineteen"
4 and inserting in place thereof the following word: — twenty-two.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July first, nineteen
2 hundred and fifty-eight.

The Constitution of the State

Article I. The Legislative Department

Section 1. The legislative power shall be vested in the Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The Senate shall be composed of twelve members, six of whom shall be chosen by the electors of each county.

Section 3. The House of Representatives shall be composed of members chosen by the electors of each county, and the number of members shall not exceed thirty.

Section 4. The members of the Senate and House of Representatives shall hold their offices for two years.
