AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF JUDGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The salaries of the chief justice and associate justices of the
2 supreme judicial court and the superior court, the judge and
3 associate judges of the land court, the judges of probate, the
4 chief justice and associate justices of the municipal court of
5 the city of Boston, and justices of district courts required to
6 give full time to the duties of their offices are hereby increased
7 by two thousand dollars, and the salaries of the justices of all
8 other district courts are hereby increased by one thousand
9 dollars.
