AN ACT FURTHER PROVIDING FOR THE SEGREGATION AND TREATMENT OF SEX OFFENDERS, SO CALLED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of chapter 123A of the General Laws, as amended by
2 chapter 772 of the acts of 1957, is further amended by striking
3 out the words "indecent exposure" as appearing in line three,
4 and inserting in place thereof the words: — assault with intent
5 to rape, — and by inserting after the word "may", in line four
6 of said section, the words: — including a justice of the district
7 court.
