AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EXEMPTION FROM LOCAL TAXATION OF
THE REAL ESTATE OWNED BY THE BOSTON TERMINAL CORPORATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

There shall be exempt from local taxation all lands and buildings
2 owned and used by the Boston Terminal Corporation, except
3 that portion or portions of said lands or buildings rented or
4 leased and used exclusively as a revenue-producing enterprise.
