AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF TAUNTON TO USE CERTAIN FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXTENDING AND IMPROVING ITS WATER SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Taunton may, for the purposes of
2 extending and improving its water system, as specified in clauses
3 (4), (5) and (6) of section 8, chapter 44, General Laws, use such
4 sums, not exceeding in the aggregate one hundred and sixty-
5 nine thousand dollars from the unexpended balance of the
6 amount borrowed under chapter five hundred and forty of the
7 acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-three.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
