To accompany the petition of Herbert S. Tuckerman and members of the House of Representatives that provision be made for a study and investigation by a special commission (including members of the General Court) relative to the construction of a State pier in the city of Salem. Harbors and Public Lands.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF A STATE PIER IN THE CITY OF SALEM.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of
2 three members of the senate to be designated by the president
3 thereof, five members of the house of representatives to be
4 designated by the speaker thereof, the commissioner of public
5 works or his designee, and two persons to be appointed by the
6 governor, is hereby established for the purpose of making a
7 thorough investigation and study relative to the feasibility
8 of constructing a state pier in the city of Salem and to the further
9 improving of the port facilities in said city. Said commission
10 shall be provided with quarters in the state house or elsewhere,
11 shall hold public hearings, and may expend such sums for expert
12 and clerical services or expenses as may be provided therefor.
13 Said commission shall report to the general court the results
14 of its investigation and study, together with drafts of legislation
15 necessary to carry its recommendations, if any, into effect, by
16 filing the same with the clerk of the senate on or before the last
17 Tuesday in December in the current year.
