AN ACT RELATIVE TO BLOOD TESTS IN ORDER TO CONTROL BRUCELLOSIS OF CATTLE IMPORTED INTO THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 129 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 striking out section 36F, inserted by section 4 of chapter 527 of  
3 the acts of 1956, and inserting in place thereof the following  
4 section: — *Section 36F.* The director, his authorized agent or  
5 a veterinarian designated by the director, shall make by random  
6 selection such blood tests for brucellosis of all cattle imported  
7 into the commonwealth which are over six months of age and  
8 unvaccinated, or over thirty months of age whether or not  
9 officially vaccinated, as will effectively control brucellosis.
