AN ACT REQUIRING A LICENSE FOR THE TAKING OF KELP, MOSS OR OTHER SEAWEED FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES OR BY MECHANICAL MEANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 130 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 102, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 598
3 of the acts of 1941, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 section: —

5 *Section 102.* No person shall take kelp, moss or other sea-
6 weed from the shores of the territorial waters of the common-
7 wealth for commercial purposes unless he has obtained a license
8 from the director as hereinafter provided, and no person shall
9 use mechanical equipment other than a knife or rake operated
10 by hand for harvesting kelp, moss or other seaweed unless he
11 has obtained such a license and unless such mechanical equipment
12 has been approved by the director. The director may, after
13 application in such form as he may determine, issue such a license
14 to a resident of the commonwealth upon payment of a fee of
15 three dollars and to a non-resident thereof upon payment of a
16 fee of fifteen dollars.

17 No person shall, for the purpose of taking and carrying away
18 kelp, moss or other seaweed, enter on upland or lawfully en-
19 closed flats without the consent of the owner or lawful occupant
20 thereof.

- 5 Section 102. No person shall take helps, mobs or other behav-
- 6 ior from the shores of the territorial waters of the common-
- 7 wealth for commercial purposes unless he has obtained a license
- 8 from the director as hereinafter provided, and no person shall
- 9 use mechanical equipment other than a knife or take operated
- 10 by hand for harvesting helps, mobs or other behavior unless he
- 11 has obtained such a license and unless such mechanical equipment
- 12 has been approved by the director. The director may after
- 13 application in such form as he may determine issue such a license
- 14 to a resident of the commonwealth upon payment of a fee of
- 15 five dollars and to a non-resident thereof upon payment of a
- 16 fee of fifteen dollars.
- 17 No person shall for the purpose of taking and carrying away
- 18 helps, mobs or other covered water or upward or lawfully tak-
- 19 ing shell fish without the consent of the owner or lawful occupant
- 20 thereof.
