## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

### AN ACT PROVIDING TENURE FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE HOUSING BOARD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The second paragraph of section 26S of chapter 121 of the  
2 General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 574 of the acts  
3 of 1946, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "au-  
4 thority", in lines 4 and 5, the words:— ; provided, however,  
5 that no employee of the state housing board who has held his  
6 office or position, including any promotion or reallocation there-  
7 from within the board, for a total period of five years of unin-  
8 terrupted service shall be involuntarily separated therefrom  
9 except subject to and in accordance with the provisions of  
10 sections forty-three and forty-five of said chapter thirty-one to  
11 the same extent as if said office or position were classified under  
12 said chapter.
