## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Eight.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONVEY CERTAIN LAND IN THE CITY OF BOSTON TO BOSTON COLLEGE HIGH SCHOOL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The metropolitan district commission, for and in behalf of  
2 the commonwealth, is hereby authorized and directed to trans-  
3 fer and convey to Boston College High School, in consideration  
4 of the waiver by said Boston College High School of any and  
5 all claims to damages arising from the taking by the metro-  
6 politan district commission under chapter seventy-nine of the  
7 General Laws on April twenty-second, nineteen hundred and  
8 fifty-four, of certain land owned by said Boston College High  
9 School and adjacent to William T. Morrissey Boulevard, a cer-  
10 tain parcel of land located in the city of Boston and bounded  
11 and described as follows:—Beginning on William T. Morrissey  
12 Boulevard at the southerly end of land owned by Boston Col-  
13 lege High School and running northeasterly a distance of 135.57  
14 feet; then turning and running southeasterly along the United  
15 States bulkhead line a distance of 1,600 feet; thence turning  
16 and running westerly a distance of about 810 feet to said Wil-  
17 liam T. Morrissey Boulevard; and thence northerly along said  
18 William T. Morrissey Boulevard to the point of beginning.
