RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL IN THE DIVISION OF EMPLOYMENT SECURITY RELATIVE TO CERTAIN CHANGES IN THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW.

1 *Resolved*, That the state advisory council in the division of
2 employment security is hereby authorized and directed to make
3 an investigation and study of the subject matter of current house
4 documents numbered 3283 relative to improving the benefits
5 under the Massachusetts employment security act; 3284 rela-
6 tive to correcting certain abuses under the Massachusetts em-
7 ployment security act and 3285 relative to extending the benefits
8 of the employment security law to certain unemployed during
9 negotiations in any labor dispute. Said council shall report to
10 the general court the results of its investigation and study, to-
11 gether with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recom-
12 mendations, if any, into effect, by filing the same with the clerk
13 of the senate on or before the last Tuesday of December in the
14 current year.
