## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Eight.

### AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CHELSEA TO BORROW MONEY FOR A MUNICIPAL HOSPITAL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of constructing an addition to  
2 the Chelsea Memorial Hospital, to contain maternity, surgical,  
3 medical, administrative and other units, and originally equip-  
4 ping the same, the city of Chelsea may borrow from time to  
5 time within a period of ten years from the passage of this act  
6 such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate,  
7 one hundred and ninety thousand dollars, and may issue bonds  
8 or notes therefor which shall bear on their face the words  
9 "Chelsea Municipal Hospital Loan, Act of 1958." Each  
10 authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan, and such  
11 loans shall be paid in not more than twenty years from their  
12 dates. Indebtedness incurred under this act shall be outside  
13 the statutory limit, and shall, except as herein provided, be  
14 subject to the provisions of chapter forty-four of the General  
15 Laws, including the limitation contained in the first paragraph  
16 of section seven thereof.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
