### AN ACT FURTHER EXTENDING THE TIME FOR THE WITHDRAWAL OF ADDITIONAL DEDUCTIONS PAID INTO THE ANNUITY SAVINGS FUND OF CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEMS.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to  
2 defeat its purpose, which is to grant to certain public employees  
3 the right to withdraw forthwith pension deductions voluntarily  
4 paid into the annuity savings fund, therefore it is hereby de-  
5 clared to be an emergency law necessary for the immediate  
6 preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 2 of chapter 656 of the acts of 1954, as amended by  
2 chapter 409 of the acts of 1956, is hereby further amended by  
3 striking out, in line 6, the word "fifty-seven" and inserting in  
4 place thereof the word: — sixty, — so as to read as follows: —  
5 *Section 2.* Withdrawal of additional deductions under paragraph  
6 (*g*) of subdivision (1) of section twenty-two of chapter thirty-  
7 two of the General Laws, as amended by section one, shall be  
8 made upon written application to the board made prior to  
9 January first, nineteen hundred and sixty.
