SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chapter 3. AN ACT EXEMPTING THE PLYMOUTH/CARVER REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT FROM ITS TEACHERS' SALARY DEFERRAL FOR FISCAL YEAR NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of section three of chapter three hundred and thirty-six of the acts of nineteen hundred and ninety-one or any other general or special law to the contrary, the Plymouth/Carver Regional School District shall not defer its teachers' compensation for the fiscal year beginning July first, nineteen hundred and ninety-two.

Chapter 4. AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PLYMOUTH PROMOTIONS FUND IN THE TOWN OF PLYMOUTH.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section fifty-three of chapter forty-four of the General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, the town of Plymouth is hereby authorized to establish in the town treasury a special account to be known as the Plymouth Promotions Fund, into which account shall be deposited certain receipts which comprise a portion of the total local room occupancy tax received annually by the town under the provisions of section three A of chapter sixty-four G of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. For the purposes of establishing the portion of the local room occupancy tax that may be deposited in the Plymouth Promotions Fund, the town is hereby authorized to deposit, commencing during fiscal year nineteen hundred and ninety-four, twenty-five percent of all local room occupancy tax receipts; in fiscal year nineteen hundred and ninety-five, thirty-five percent of all receipts from said tax; in fiscal year nineteen hundred and ninety-six, forty-five percent of all receipts from said tax; and in each fiscal year subsequent to fiscal year nineteen hundred and ninety-six, forty-five percent of all local room occupancy tax receipts shall be deposited in said fund. All interest earned from said fund shall be treated as general fund revenue of the town of Plymouth.

SECTION 3. There is hereby established in the town of Plymouth a visitor services board consisting of seven members to be appointed by the board of selectmen, as follows: one member nominated by the Plymouth area chamber of commerce, one member nominated
