AN ACT TO FURTHER ADJUST THE SALARIES OF THE EMPLOYEES
OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Any employee of the city of Boston who occupies any posi-
2 tion, whose regularly assigned hours of duty are more than half
3 between six postmeridian and six antemeridian, shall be paid a
4 salary rate for said position, plus an additional ten cents an hour.
