AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE AUTHORIZATION OF A YOUTH GOVERNMENT DAY IN EACH CITY AND TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 39 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
- 2 serting after section 10 the following section:—
- 3 *Section 10A.* **Each city and town shall authorize and es-**
- 4 **tablish a youth government day. An election according**
- 5 **to parliamentary procedure shall be held within the school**
- 6 **system to fill such offices as presently exist in each re-**
- 7 **spective city and town. Said election shall, in a town be**
- 8 **held under the joint supervision of the school committee**
- 9 **and the selectmen and in a city under the joint super-**
- 10 **vision of the school committee and the council.**
