AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO WIDEN THE UNDERPASS ON EAST MOUNTAIN ROAD IN THE CITY OF WESTFIELD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The state department of public works is hereby  
2 authorized and directed to reconstruct and widen the underpass  
3 located on East Mountain road between Westfield road and  
4 northerly to Route 202 in the city of Westfield, and may expend  
5 such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

The Constitution of the United States

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA: AS AMENDED BY THE THIRTEENTH, FOURTEENTH, AND FIFTEENTH AMENDMENTS.

As amended by the Thirteenth, Fourteenth, and Fifteenth Amendments.

Article I. Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.
