## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Nine.

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE TIME WITHIN WHICH COUNTIES, CITIES, TOWNS AND DISTRICTS MAY INCUR DEBT TO SECURE THE BENEFITS PROVIDED BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TO ASSIST THEM IN PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to  
2 defeat its purpose, which is to make available without interrup-  
3 tion to counties, cities, towns and districts financial assistance  
4 by the federal government for public works projects, therefore  
5 it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the  
6 immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 6 of chapter 74 of the acts of 1945, as most recently  
2 amended by chapter 222 of the acts of 1957, is hereby further  
3 amended by striking out, in line 4, the word "fifty-nine" and  
4 inserting in place thereof the word:—sixty-one,—so as to  
5 read as follows:—*Section 6.* Loans by counties, cities, towns  
6 and districts may be authorized under the provisions of this act  
7 until July first, nineteen hundred and sixty-one.
