AN ACT RELATIVE TO MUNICIPAL PENSIONS OF SCHOOL JANITORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section 45B the following section:—

3 *Section 45C.* In any city or town which has accepted sec-
4 tions forty-four and forty-four A in the manner set forth in
5 section forty-five and which accepts this section, the pension
6 payable to a person retired under said section forty-four shall
7 be one half of the highest annual compensation received by him
8 while holding the grade held by him at the time of his retirement
9 if he has completed twenty years of service, and an additional
10 amount equal to one per cent of said annual compensation for
11 each year of service after the first twenty; provided, that the
12 total amount of such pension shall in no case exceed sixty-five
13 per cent of said annual compensation.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply to the pensions of school
2 janitors retired prior to the effective date of this act, as well as
3 to those retired on or after said effective date.
