## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Nine.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES TO CONVEY CERTAIN LAND TO THE INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF BILLERICA TO BE USED FOR INDUSTRIAL PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The department of natural resources in the name  
2 and on behalf of the commonwealth, is hereby authorized and di-  
3 rected to sell or exchange to the industrial commission of the  
4 town of Billerica, for industrial purposes, certain forest land,  
5 located in the Massachusetts state forest in or near the town  
6 of Billerica. Said land is now under the control of the depart-  
7 ment of natural resources.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

The Constitution of the United States

Article I, Section 1

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 1. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of the whole Number of free Persons, who are twenty Years of Age, seven Years Citizens, and who, when elected, shall have been seven Years in the United States; but no Person shall be Representative of any State unless he shall, when elected, have seven Years Residence in that State: And the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

Section 3. The Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.
