### AN ACT REQUIRING AN EXHAUST PIPE EXTENSION ON DIESEL EQUIPPED BUSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 7 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by section 1 of chapter 570 of the acts of 1954, is hereby
- 3 amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:—
- 4 Every bus powered by a diesel engine shall be equipped with an
- 5 exhaust pipe extension which terminates at a point above the
- 6 top of said vehicle.
