By Mr. Catino of Medford (by request), petition of the Liquor Dealer's Association of Massachusetts and another that certain licensees be permitted to serve alcoholic beverages at bars or counters on Sundays. Legal Affairs.

AN ACT PERMITTING CERTAIN LICENSEES TO SERVE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT BARS OR COUNTERS ON SUNDAYS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The second paragraph of section 12 of chapter 138, as most
2 recently amended by section 4 of chapter 542 of the acts of
3 1943, is hereby further amended by striking out all after the
4 word "stools" in line 5, — so that said paragraph shall read as
5 follows: —

6 No alcoholic beverage shall on secular days be served to or
7 drunk by a woman as patron, guest or member in a public room
8 or area of a hotel, or in a restaurant or club, licensed under this
9 section, except while seated at a table or seated at a bar or
10 counter equipped with stools.
