AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE JUDGES OF PROBATE IN THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 217 is hereby amended by striking out
2 the first sentence thereof and substituting in place thereof the
3 following sentence: — There shall be four judges of probate in
4 the county of Suffolk, three in the county of Middlesex and two
5 judges of probate in each of the counties of Essex, Worcester,
6 Hampden, Bristol and Norfolk.
