RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION OF THE UNITED INTERCHANGE INC., AND THE UNITED INTERCHANGE INC. OF MASSACHUSETTS BY AN UNPAID SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO CERTAIN UNETHICAL BUSINESS PRACTICES IN THE FIELD OF REAL ESTATE.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of  
2 three members of the senate to be designated by the president  
3 thereof, five members of the house of representatives to be  
4 designated by the speaker thereof and two persons to be ap-  
5 pointed by the governor, is hereby established for the purpose  
6 of investigating the United Interchange Inc. and the United  
7 Interchange Inc. of Massachusetts relative to certain unethical  
8 business practices in the field of real estate. Said commission  
9 shall be provided with quarters in the state house or elsewhere,  
10 shall hold hearings, shall have the power to summon witnesses  
11 and to require the production of books and papers, and the  
12 giving of testimony under oath, and may employ technical  
13 assistants and expend for clerical and other services and ex-  
14 penses such sums as may hereafter be appropriated therefor.  
15 Said commission shall report to the general court the results of  
16 its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,  
17 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recom-  
18 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the  
19 house of representatives on or before the fourth Wednesday of  
20 January, nineteen hundred and sixty.
