

HOUSE No. 1663

By Mr. Crane of Boston, petition of John B. Hynes (mayor) that the city of Boston be authorized to sell at private sale certain bonds and notes now authorized to be sold at public sale. Municipal Finance.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO SELL AT PRIVATE SALE CERTAIN BONDS AND NOTES NOW AUTHORIZED TO BE SOLD AT PUBLIC SALE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5B of chapter 474 of the acts of 1946, as
2 inserted by section 1 of chapter 450 of the acts of 1955, is hereby
3 amended by inserting after the word "public", in line 6, the
4 words: — or private.

1 SECTION 2. Section 1A of chapter 164 of the acts of 1954, as
2 inserted by section 1 of chapter 718 of the acts of 1957, is hereby
3 amended by inserting after the word "public", in line 5, the
4 words: — or private.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

The Constitution of the United States

Article I. Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

1. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

2. No Person shall be a Representative who shall not have attained to the Age of twenty five Years, seven Years shall have elapsed since the Migration of the said Person into the United States, and who shall not, when elected, have seven Years been seven Years in the United States.

3. Representatives and Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

4. No Person shall be a Representative who shall not have attained to the Age of twenty five Years, seven Years shall have elapsed since the Migration of the said Person into the United States, and who shall not, when elected, have seven Years been seven Years in the United States.

5. Representatives and Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.
