AN ACT ADJUSTING THE SALARIES OF THE CHAIRMAN AND MEMBERS  
OF THE APPELLATE TAX BOARD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1 of chapter 58A of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the fourth sentence, as amended by  
3 chapter 732 of the acts of 1957, and inserting in place thereof  
4 the following sentence:— The chairman of said board shall  
5 receive a salary of fifteen thousand dollars and each other  
6 member shall receive a salary of fourteen thousand dollars.
