AN ACT PERMITTING THE TOWING AWAY OF MOTOR VEHICLES ILLEGALLY PARKED ON PRIVATE PROPERTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 266 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting after section 120A, as most recently amended by chap-
3 ter 269 of the act of 1955, the following new section: —

4 *Section 120B.* Any officer in charge of a police station when
5 notified by the owner or a person in charge of private property
6 that a motor vehicle has been without right parked on his
7 property may authorize the motor vehicle removed by towing
8 and the expense of such towing shall be paid by the registered
9 owner of the motor vehicle.
