AN ACT PROHIBITING INSURED PERSONS FROM CHANGING INSURANCE AGENTS WHILE OWING A SUM OF MONEY TO SAID AGENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 175 of the General Laws, is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 162B, as inserted by chapter 464 of the
- 3 acts of 1954, the following new section: —
- 4 *Section 162C.* An insurance company shall not issue a policy
- 5 of insurance if the insured thereon shall owe a sum of money
- 6 to an insurance agent or broker.
