AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO EXPEND TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS TO RENOVATE THE ROBERT GOULD SHAW MONUMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston is hereby authorized to
2 appropriate and expend a sum not exceeding twenty-five thou-
3 sand dollars for the purpose of repairing and renovating the
4 Robert Gould Shaw monument located on the Boston common.
