AN ACT GRANTING UNLIMITED TENURE OF OFFICE TO THE PRESENT INCUMBENTS OF THE OFFICES OF COMMISSIONER OF VETERANS' SERVICES AND THE FIRST AND SECOND DEPUTY COMMISSIONERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of any general or
2 special law, the present incumbents of the offices or positions of
3 commissioner of veterans' services, first deputy commissioner of
4 veterans' services and second deputy commissioner of veterans'
5 services are hereby given unlimited tenure of office therein, and
6 shall not be involuntarily separated from their service as such,
7 except for cause, after a hearing by the appointing authority.

The House of Representatives and the Senate have passed the bill which provides for the establishment of a National Commission on the Causes and Prevention of Violence. The bill is now in conference committee.
