AN ACT DIRECTING THE BOSTON AND MAINE RAILROAD TO DIS-
MANTLE A BRIDGE IN THE TOWN OF BERLIN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Boston and Maine railroad shall dismantle
2 its overhead bridge passing over route 62 in the town of Berlin
3 and shall remove the stone pillars supporting the same.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
