RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO NOISE PROBLEMS CREATED BY JET, TURBO JET AND OTHER AIRCRAFT AT LOGAN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT IN EAST BOSTON.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of
2 two members of the senate to be designated by the president
3 thereof, three members of the house of representatives to be
4 designated by the speaker thereof, and two persons to be ap-
5 pointed by the governor, is hereby established for the purpose
6 of making an investigation and study of the problems created by
7 the use of jet, turbo jet and other aircraft with particular
8 reference to the noise made in their operation at Logan Inter-
9 national airport in the East Boston section of the city of Boston
10 and the feasibility of alleviating such conditions. Said com-
11 mission shall be provided with quarters in the state house or
12 elsewhere, may hold hearings, may travel within or without
13 the commonwealth and may expend for legal, clerical and other
14 assistance such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said
15 commission shall report to the general court the results of its
16 investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
17 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry said recom-
18 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the
19 senate not later than the last Wednesday of January, nineteen
20 hundred and sixty.
