AN ACT PROVIDING FOR LIFE TENURE FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF
THE LYNN MEDICAL CENTER IN THE CITY OF LYNN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The tenure of office of the present nurses and
2 practical nurses employed at the Lynn Medical center in the
3 city of Lynn, shall be unlimited. Said incumbents shall not be
4 removed from their positions, lowered in rank or suspended
5 except in accordance with the provisions of section forty-three,
6 of chapter thirty-one, of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
