AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A SECOND SPECIAL JUSTICE IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF LAWRENCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by section 1 of chapter 744 of the acts of 1956,
3 is hereby amended by striking out the second paragraph and
4 inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:—

5 Except in the municipal court of the city of Boston, there
6 shall be two special justices in every district court having two
7 justices and one special justice in every other district court,
8 **except that there shall be two special justices in the dis-**
9 **trict court of Lawrence.** No vacancy in the office of special
10 justice shall be filled unless and until the number of special
11 justices for such court shall be less than the number provided
12 therefor in this section.
