## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Nine.

AN ACT RELATING TO BILLBOARDS IN THE TOWN OF STURBRIDGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of sections twenty-nine to  
2 thirty-three, inclusive, of chapter ninety-three of the General  
3 Laws, or of any other special or general law, no application for  
4 license to erect a billboard in the town of Sturbridge shall be  
5 approved without the written approval of the majority of the  
6 selectmen thereof.
