AN ACT PROVIDING FOR MONTHLY INSPECTION OF PUBLIC SCHOOL BUILDINGS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3D of chapter 143 of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by section 2 of chapter 482 of the acts of 1945,
3 is hereby amended by striking out the first paragraph and
4 inserting in place thereof the following paragraph: —

5 The commissioner, or his authorized representative referred
6 to in section three A, may inspect at any time any theatre,
7 special hall, public hall, schoolhouse, church or any building,
8 portion of a building or room in which any place of assembly is
9 located, for the purpose of ascertaining whether or not there is or
10 has been a violation of any law, rule or regulation, ordinance or
11 by-law relative to places of assembly, and shall report any such
12 violation to the officer or board charged with the duty of the en-
14 forcement thereof. **The commissioner or his authorized**
15 **representative referred to in section three A shall inspect**
16 **each public schoolhouse in the commonwealth monthly**
17 **for the purpose of ascertaining whether or not there is a**
18 **violation of any law, rule or regulation, ordinance or**
19 **by-law relative to such schoolhouse, and shall report any**
20 **such violations to the officer or board charged with the**
21 **duty of the enforcement thereof.**
