AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE
COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provisions of law special or general to
2 the contrary, the annual salaries of all employees of the com-
3 monwealth shall be increased by the sum of seven hundred and
4 twenty dollars.
