RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A YOUTH CONSERVATION CORPS TO COMBAT JUVENILE DELINQUENCY, CONSERVE OUR NATURAL RESOURCES AND ERECT RADIATION SHELTERS.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of
2 five members of the house of representatives to be designated
3 by the speaker thereof, three members of the senate to be desig-
4 nated by the president thereof, and three members to be ap-
5 pointed by the governor, is hereby established for the purpose
6 of making an investigation and study relative to creating a
7 youth conservation corps to combat juvenile delinquency,
8 such corps to be employed in reforestation work and the con-
9 struction of shelters to protect the public from the damaging
10 effect of radiation in the event of enemy attack. Said commis-
11 sion shall be provided with quarters in the state house or else-
12 where, may hold hearings, travel within and without the com-
13 monwealth, employ experts, clerical and other assistants, and
14 may expend such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

15 Said commission shall report to the general court the results
16 of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
17 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry said recom-
18 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the
19 house of representatives on or before the fourth Wednesday of
20 January in the year nineteen hundred and sixty.
