AN ACT TO VALIDATE ACTION OF THE SPECIAL TOWN MEETING HELD IN THE TOWN OF AGAWAM ON AUGUST EIGHTEENTH, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY-EIGHT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All action of the special town meeting held in
2 the town of Agawam on August eighteenth, nineteen hundred
3 and fifty-eight, is hereby validated.

1 SECTION 2. The sewer bonds voted under Article 9 of the
2 warrant for the meeting referred to in paragraph one hereof may
3 be issued without approval by state or federal authorities other-
4 wise required by chapter seventy-four of the acts of nineteen
5 hundred and forty-five, as amended.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
