AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF NEWBURYPORT TO INCREASE THE PENSION OF GEORGE H. LAWLER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Newburyport is hereby authorized to
2 increase the pension of George H. Lawler, a retired patrolman
3 who is totally disabled as result of being shot while in the per-
4 formance of his duties as a police officer of said city. Said pen-
5 sion shall be increased to an amount equal to the present annual
6 rate payable to a patrolman in said city.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance
2 by vote of the city council of said city, subject to the provisions
3 of its charter, but not otherwise.
