AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF DUKES COUNTY TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE COST OF DREDGING OAK BLUFFS HARBOR AND CONSTRUCTING A BULKHEAD ALONG THE SHORES THEREOF.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The county of Dukes County is hereby author-
2 ized to contribute to the cost of dredging Oak Bluffs harbor
3 and constructing a timber bulkhead along the shores thereof,
4 said projects to be carried out during the year nineteen hundred
5 and fifty-nine by the state department of public works under
6 authority of section eleven of chapter ninety-one of the General
7 Laws. The county treasurer of said county, with the approval
8 of the county commissioners, for the purpose of so contributing,
9 may borrow from time to time on the credit of the county such
10 sums as may be necessary, not exceeding in the aggregate
11 twenty thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes of the
12 county therefor, which shall bear on their face the words County
13 of Dukes County Harbor Improvement Loan, Act of 1959.
14 Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan and such
15 loans shall be payable in not more than four years from their
16 date. Such bonds or notes shall be signed by the county treas-
17 urer and countersigned by a majority of the county commis-
18 sioners. The county may sell such securities at public or private
19 sale upon such terms and conditions as the county commis-
20 sioners may deem proper, but not for less than their par value.
21 Indebtedness incurred under this act shall, except as herein
22 provided, be subject to chapter thirty-five of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
