AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF THE CLERK OF COMMITTEES IN THE CITY OF FALL RIVER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 187 of the acts of 1938 is hereby amended
2 by striking out section 1 and inserting in place thereof the follow-
3 ing section: —

4 *Section 1.* The clerk of committees in the city of Fall River
5 shall, beginning with the first Monday of January in the year
6 nineteen hundred and sixty, be appointed by the city council,
7 to hold office for two years and until his successor is qualified,
8 notwithstanding any provision of chapter forty-three of the
9 General Laws to the contrary.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 vote of the city council of said city, subject to the provisions of
3 its charter, but not otherwise.
