AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ACCEPTANCE BY THE TOWN OF CLINTON OF THE PROVISIONS OF LAW ESTABLISHING MINIMUM ANNUAL COMPENSATION FOR FIREFIGHTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any contrary provision of sec-
2 tion fifty-eight A of chapter fifty-four of the General Laws, the
3 following question shall be placed upon the official ballot to be
4 used for the election of officers at the annual town meeting to be
5 held in the town of Clinton in the current year: — “Shall the
6 town vote to accept the provisions of section one hundred and
7 eight D of chapter forty-one of the General Laws, whereby, if
8 accepted, the minimum annual compensation of each permanent
9 firefighter in the fire department of the town of Clinton will be
10 not less than five thousand dollars?”

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
