AN ACT DESIGNATING THE SOFTBALL FIELD IN THE STONY BROOK RESERVATION AS THE SAMUEL S. GELEWITZ FIELD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The newly constructed softball field located in the Stony
- 2 Brook reservation in the Hyde Park district of the city of
- 3 Boston shall be known and designated as the Samuel S. Gelewitz
- 4 Field. A suitable tablet or marker bearing such designation
- 5 honoring Gelewitz, a deceased war veteran, shall be erected at
- 6 said field by the metropolitan district commission.
