AN ACT GRANTING THE CONSENT OF THE COMMONWEALTH TO A
PETITION BY GEMMA FROIO.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Gemma Froio of Malden is hereby authorized,
2 within six months after the passage of this act, to bring a petition
3 against the commonwealth under the provisions of chapter two
4 hundred and fifty-eight of the General Laws that the court de-
5 termine whether, in the manner and subject to the limitations,
6 conditions and restrictions specified in section fifteen of chapter
7 eighty-four of the General Laws, but not including the require-
8 ments relative to a written notice as specified in sections eight-
9 een and nineteen of said chapter eighty-four, injuries sustained
10 by her on or about April sixteenth, nineteen hundred and fifty-
11 seven, were caused by a defect or want of repair of a way or
12 sidewalk on Highland avenue in the city of Malden under the
13 control of the metropolitan district commission and, if the court
14 shall so determine, to find the amount of her damages.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
