AN ACT PROHIBITING THE GRANTING OF TRAFFIC OUTLETS BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO OR FROM CERTAIN LAND IN THE CITY OF MEDFORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any other provision of law the metropolitan
2 district commission is hereby prohibited from permitting any
3 traffic outlet to or from the land located at the westerly corner
4 of Fellsway West to Surrey street and Charles street in the city
5 of Medford.
