AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION TO THE VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF READING OF A QUESTION PERTAINING TO THE FLUORIDE SUPPLEMENTATION OF ITS WATER SUPPLY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 At a special town meeting in the town of Reading which shall
2 be held in the current year, there shall be submitted to the
3 voters the following question which shall be printed upon the
4 ballot to be used at said meeting: — “Are you in favor of fluoride
5 supplementation of the Reading water supply?” If a majority
6 of those voting vote in favor of such supplementation it shall
7 be deemed and taken to be the will of the voters of said town
8 that the public water supply shall continue to be fluoridated,
9 and if a majority of said votes is in the negative, it shall be
10 deemed and taken to be the will of said voters that such supply
11 shall not be fluoridated.
