RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL RELATIVE TO PROHIBITING THE PRACTICE OF LAW BY REAL ESTATE BROKERS AND CONSTABLES.

2 the subject matter of current house document numbered 1962,
3 relative to prohibiting the practice of law by real estate brokers
4 and constables, and to include its conclusions and its recom-
5 mendations, if any, in relation thereto, together with drafts of
6 such legislation as may be necessary to give effect to the same,
7 in its annual report for the current year.
