## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Nine.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF NANTUCKET TO BORROW MONEY FOR RECONSTRUCTING AND MAKING EXTRAORDINARY REPAIRS TO ITS SEWER FORCE MAIN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of reconstructing and making  
2 extraordinary repairs to the sewer force main, the town of  
3 Nantucket may borrow within a period of two years from the  
4 passage of this act, such sum or sums as may be necessary, not  
5 exceeding seventy-five thousand dollars, and may issue bonds  
6 or notes therefor, which shall bear on their face the words,  
7 Nantucket Sewer Reconstruction Loan, Act of 1959, and such  
8 loan or loans shall be paid in not more than ten years from its  
9 date.

1 SECTION 2. Any action taken under authority of this act at  
2 the annual or a special town meeting of the town of Nantucket  
3 held in the current year shall be as effective in all respects as  
4 though this act had been in full force and effect on the date  
5 when the warrant for such meeting was posted.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
